


WHY TODAY MATTERS

INCREASING ACCESS TO LOCAL FARMERS MARKETS



The program provides EBT shoppers who receive Basic Food assistance the ability to receive up to \$10 using Fresh Bucks to purchase fresh fruits, vegetables, and edible plants at participating farmers markets in the Seattle area.

Help increase participation in the Fresh Bucks program and raise awareness of the program among key diverse communities who qualify for EBT benefits.
